

A Brief Installation Guide for Linux Users of AntConc

1. Download the appropriate file (latest version at time of writing antconc3.1.303_linux)
2. Change file permissions using the chmod command in the download folder. Open a terminal window as root and type:
3. `$ chmod a+rwx antconc3.1.303_linux`
4. Now double-clicking on the icon should open antconc. You can also launch from the command line with `./antconc3.1.303_linux`
5. If you don't want the file in your /home directory, move it to, for example /usr/bin with the mv command:
6. `$ mv antconc3.1.303_linux /usr/bin`
7. To launch from c-line type `antconc3.1.303_linux`
8. To create a desktop launcher with gnome, right-click on the desktop then type in `/usr/bin/antconc3.1.303_linux` in the command-line prompt or browse to this location.
